Highway 35/115 Interchange (WP 4174-15-00)

Preliminary Design Study and Class Environmental Assessment

STUDY

The Ontario **Ministry of Transportation (MTO)** has retained **WSP Canada Group Limited** to undertake a Preliminary Design and Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for the Highway 35/115 Interchange in the Municipality of Clarington. The study area is shown on the key plan.

The objectives of the study include:

- Improvements to Highway 35/115 Interchange;
- Tie the Highway 35/115 interchange into the previously approved Highway 35 improvements;
- Rehabilitation/widening/replacement of structures in the study area;
- Addressing local access needs; and
- Drainage improvements.

PROCESS

This study is following the approved environmental planning process for Group 'B' projects under the *Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities (2000)*.

Upon completion of the Preliminary Design, a Transportation Environmental Study Report (TESR) will be prepared and made available for public review. The TESR will document the existing conditions, transportation opportunities, consultation undertaken, generation, assessment and evaluation of alternatives, the recommended plan, and a summary of environmental issues, potential mitigation measures and commitments to future works. The Notice of TESR submission for public review will be advertised in local newspapers, posted on the project website and sent to those on the study contact list.

PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2

The first Public Information Centre (PIC) was held in March 2019. The second PIC has been arranged to focus on the evaluation of alternatives and the preferred Preliminary Design, along with presenting anticipated environmental impacts and proposed mitigation strategies.

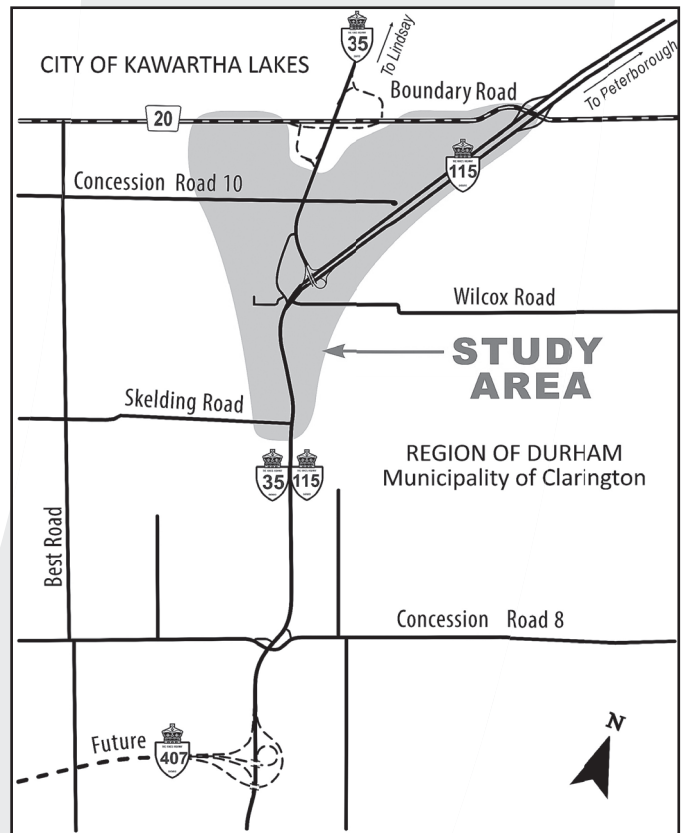
